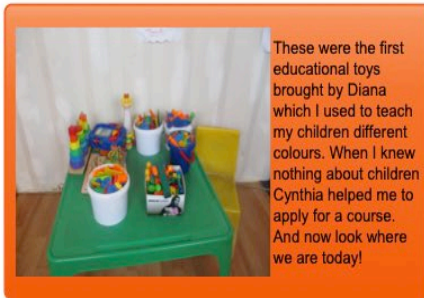


# The communities' evaluation of Ubunye's work in 2019 through photos

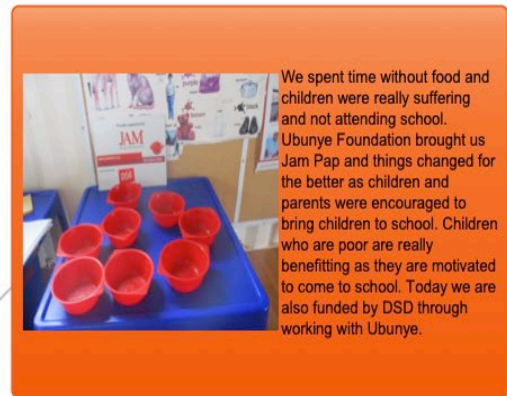
## A Photo Essay using PhotoVoice

These were the first educational toys brought by Diana which I used to teach my children different colours. When I knew nothing about children Cynthia helped me to apply for a course. And now look where we are today!

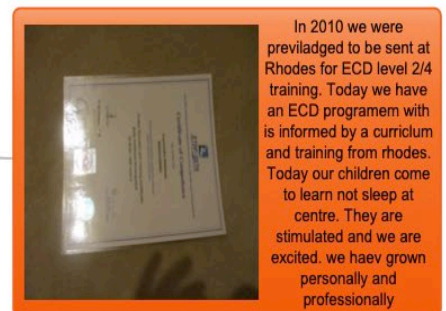
